Grain Bank Policy

- Grain Bank is defined as corn delivered to or purchased from Frontier Coop for the purpose of feeding livestock.
- All Grain Bank corn must be processed or used in a feed ration.
- No other grains can be placed in a Grain Bank position.
- Corn that is delivered to Frontier Coop and placed in Grain Bank will be dried and shrunk to 14% and normal quality discounts will apply.
- Grain Bank corn will have free storage for the first 60 days and then the normal storage rate of \$.00165/bushel/day will begin.
- Storage will be billed twice a year on June 30th and December 31st and will be prorated based on the date the corn was placed in Grain Bank.
- Whole corn sold or hauled out of grain bank will be charged handling fees of \$.20/bushel in and \$.20/bushel out.
